Pasture and forage consisted mainly of grasses, with an interspersed of legumes and other forbs, is plant material eaten by grazing livestock directly as pasture, crop residue, or immature cereal crops, but it also includes similar plants cut for fodder and carried to the animals, especially as hay or silage.

In addition, grasses also contribute to improving soil physical and chemical properties, maintaining the soil fertility, windbreak and sand-fixation, conserving soil and water, greening the environment and climate regulation.

- Grass planting
- Pasture and grazing
