In this special issue, we invite front-line researchers and authors to submit original research and review articles that explore **water resources sustainable development**. In this special issue, potential topics include, but are not limited to:

- Integrated water resources development and management
- Water resources assessment
- Protection of water resources, water quality and aquatic ecosystems
- Drinking water supply and sanitation
- Water and sustainable urban development
- Water for sustainable food production and rural development
- Impacts of climate change on water resources
