

Urticaria, is a kind of skin rash with red, raised, itchy bumps.^[1] They may also burn or sting.^[2] Often the patches of rash move around.^[2] Typically they last a few days and do not leave any long-lasting skin changes.^[2] Fewer than 5% of cases last for more than six weeks.^[2] The condition frequently recurs.^[2]

In the present book, fifteen typical literatures about urticaria development published on international authoritative journals were selected to introduce the worldwide newest progress, which contains reviews or original researches on urticaria. We hope this book can demonstrate advances in urticaria development as well as give references to the researchers, students and other related people.
