**Cardiac Arrest** is a sudden stop in effective blood circulation due to failure of the heart to contract effectively or at all. Cardiac arrest is a medical emergency that, in certain situations, is potentially reversible if treated early. Unexpected cardiac arrest can lead to death within minutes: this is called **sudden cardiac death** (SCD).

In this special issue, we intend to invite front-line researchers and authors to submit original researches and review articles on exploring **cardiac arrest and sudden cardiac death**. Potential topics include, but are not limited to:

- Signs and symptoms of cardiac arrest
- Causes of cardiac arrest and sudden death
- CPR and defibrillation
- Medications
- Epidemiology
- Prevention of cardiac arrest and sudden death
