Substance abuse is use of a drug in amounts or by methods which are harmful to the individual or others. It is a form of substance-related disorder. In addition to possible physical, social, and psychological harm, use of some drugs may also lead to criminal penalties, although these vary widely depending on the local jurisdiction. Substance dependence is an adaptive state that develops from repeated drug administration, and which results in withdrawal upon cessation of drug use.
