Drawing up a business model in the service ecosystem perspective means creating a community of interacting actors who share and exchange their resources in order to adapt to the environment and co-evolve for mutual benefits: business models may be advantageously interpreted according to the service ecosystem lens since every actor engaged in business processes can be seen as a complex service system capable of creating social and economic wellbeing thanks to resource integration processes, institutional arrangement, alignment of individual goals towards the ultimate finality of value co-creation.
